The camp will feature advanced training techniques, tactical sessions and lectures, and full-sided matches in the evening. The camp will feature daily speakers on a wide array of topics including the recruiting process for the older girls. Players will be challenged daily by playing small and full-sided games. **Those who wish to attend individually, in a small group, or with a friend, may register as "independents". Upon arrival at camp "independents" will be combined to form a team, or be placed on an existing registered team that may need to add players.** College coaches will highlight the staff during this week.

The Central Illinois Soccer Academy (CISA) staff recognizes the demands placed upon High School age players during this critical time in their soccer careers to both train for the upcoming high school season and be identified as prospective student-athletes by colleges and universities throughout the country. In an effort to continue to provide quality training and college exposure at our Girls and Boys HS Age Camps in a cost effective manner, the CISA Staff is very excited to offer a new training model.

DESCRIPTION: When registering for the "Match Team Only" option, registrants will be accepted as part of a high school team, club team, or select team and must have a minimum of 13 participants. The "select team" option is available for those players that may not have enough members in their high school or club team, but would still like to participate in a high level training and playing environment. All "Match Team Only" participants will have the opportunity to be coached by the entire CISA Staff.

FORMAT: "Match Team Only" registrants will receive a 45 minute tactical instruction prior to the match, followed by a technical warm-up, and a match consisting of two 40 minute halves. At the conclusion of the match your team will have a 10-15minute match analysis including an evaluation of the implementation of tactics discussed. In total each "team" will receive 5 tactical sessions, 5 matches, and 5 Match Analysis discussions.

BOYS ADVANCED TEAM AND SENIOR AGE PLAYER CAMP

This specialized camp is designed to meet the needs of advanced high school age players in a team setting. In the last four years, the BOYS ADVANCED TEAM AND SENIOR AGE PLAYER CAMP, showcased 19 teams and over 250

participants in a competitive learning environment. Several of the teams and/or players in attendance went on to garnish #1 seeds (22 in the past 8 years), advance to sectional, supersectional, state final competition, or state final championship-with their high school teams. The camp focuses on the specific technical and tactical needs of the team, enabling teams to begin preparations for fall seasons in a contained, focused, and competitive environment. The camp features advanced training techniques, full- and small-sided tournaments against comparable age high school or club teams and daily speakers on a wide array of topics, including: college preparation and recruitment, strength and conditioning, nutrition, advanced training techniques, and a segment entitled: "Athletes Talking to Athletes," where college players speak with CISA players about the athletic, academic and social components of the game at the high school and college levels. **Space is limited to 15 to 18 teams and 270 participants. Players who wish to attend individually, in a small group, or with a friend, may register as "independents". The last four team camps have been filled in numbers and teams; therefore, please register promptly. Upon arrival at camp "independents" will be combined to form a team, or be placed on an existing registered team that may need to add a "few" players.** The staff during this week is perhaps one of the strongest in the entire Midwest and is highlighted by college coaches from the Division I, II, III, NAIA and junior college ranks. CAMP INFORMATION

FACILITIES: The CISA will be held at Peoria's Detweiller and Mossville Sports Complex, two of the premier sports facilities in Central Illinois, and Bradley campus area sites-Franciscan Recreation Center and Guardian Angel Fields. Morton camps will be held at McClallen Park. Residential campers will be housed in Air Conditioned accommodations at Bradley University, and have meals in the campus dining facilities. **Directions will be sent to each camper along with confirmation of payment.**

POOL: Residential and Extended Day Camps for July weeks will have pool time in the newly constructed Markin Recreational Center. Participants are fully supervised by certified lifeguards.

SUPERVISION: CISA coaching staff members will live in the residence halls with residential campers, providing 24 hour adult supervision. In addition, fully qualified medical trainers will be on call and attend all sessions. Bradley University provides dormitory and campus security. Only campers, CISA staff, and certified campus personnel, have keys to access stairway doors and elevators.

CAMP BALL: All campers will be **REQUIRED** to bring their own soccer ball with them. Each ball should be clearly marked with the camper's name. A pump will be provided at the fields.

EQUIPMENT: A complete equipment checklist will be sent to each player along with confirmation of payment.

EXTENDED DAY CAMPS: Extended day campers receive the full instruction and training presented in the residential and team camps. Breakfast and lodging are the only omissions. **All Extended Day Campers are to check-in between 3:30 and 4:00 p.m. on either Sunday July 11 or July 25.**

MEALS: Junior Day Camp participants will be required to bring their own snacks and drinks. Coolers will be provided for storage. Three meals will be served at residential camps. (Meals are limited to lunch and dinner for extended day campers).

PAYMENT PROCEDURES: Each application must either be accompanied by a \$50 **non-refundable** deposit or paid in full. **The CISA will not be accepting the remaining balance payment prior to check-in.** Payment can be made in the form of personal check, money order, cashier's check, traveler's check, credit card, or cash. **Please make checks payable to: Central Illinois Soccer Academy.**

SPECIAL REQUESTS: With summer schedules hectic, there will be times due to prior commitments that campers need to have flexibility in their arrival and departure times. These conditions can be accommodated for. Please call in advance if you have any special circumstances.
